

The Journal of Bone & Joint Surgery has seen a doubling of manuscript submissions over the past ten years. We pride ourselves on publishing the best, most comprehensive peer-reviewed scientific articles in orthopaedics. However, this influx of manuscripts presents major challenges for us: it burdens our reviewers, increases office overhead, and can lead to longer turnaround times and delays in returning decisions to our authors.

To meet the increasing demand for manuscript review, it is necessary for us to implement a \$250 manuscript submission fee for unsolicited scientific (Clinical and Research) manuscripts submitted to *The Journal of Bone & Joint Surgery*. This fee was determined after careful consideration of the full complement of costs associated with facilitating the peer review process. Additionally and independently, a study was undertaken by the European Union's Peer Project to evaluate the cost of content management of peer review and arrived at a similar figure.

The fee is non-refundable and is due on all new submissions (including those of papers that have been previously declined) of scientific (Clinical and Research) articles. The fee must be paid in full when the article is first submitted or it will not move forward in the review process. **Fees cannot be refunded.**

Submission fees for unsolicited scientific (Clinical or Research) articles to *The Journal of Bone & Joint Surgery* may be waived if all authors reside in any of the countries <u>listed here</u>. If your manuscript qualifies, check the box next to "request waiver" on the manuscript submission page.
