In the above example, starting from the top, note:

1. TABLE is all caps.
2. III is Roman numeral.
3. Each major word of column head is capped.
4. Units are lower case, abbreviated, italic, and in parentheses.
5. First word in each row is capped, rest are lower case.
6. Footnotes are run in the following order:
  - \* (asterisk)
  - † (single dagger)
  - ‡ (double dagger)
  - § (section symbol)
  - # (number symbol)
  - \*\* (two asterisks)
  - †† (two daggers)
